



SEEING STRAY CATS?

FREE SPAY/NEUTER FOR OUTDOOR COMMUNITY CATS!*

Community cats are the ownerless stray or feral cats who live outdoors in our neighborhoods. Best Friends Animal Society humanely traps, spays or neuters, vaccinates and ear-tips community cats. (Ear-tipping is the universal symbol of a spayed or neutered outdoor cat.) Once they recover, cats are returned to their areas, and their numbers are reduced over time.

BENEFITS OF SPAY/NEUTER:

- Prevents unwanted litters
- Saves taxpayer dollars by keeping cats out of municipal shelters
- Decreases the number of cats dying in shelters
- Helps improve the health of outdoor cats
- Reduces nuisance behaviors like spraying, fighting, howling and roaming
